Other Grant Update & Activities:

The Americorps Farm-to-School program is pleased to report that Magdalen Dale, Community Outreach Member, will serve another part-time, one-year term. Brittany Schmitt has given her resignation as nutrition member and that position has been posted. Thank you Brittany! The vacancy noticed closes on August 15.

The Bayfield Summer VISTA volunteer, Lucia Damberg, has been very active leading school garden maintenance and Junior Master Gardening Classes as well as a presence at the farmer's market on Saturday mornings.

We have been notified that we will receive \$18,500 for Year 4 of the Hope for tomorrow Ojibwe Language Revitalization project.

Our project contact at WI DPI has issued an award letter to Bayfield in the amount of \$100,000 for Year 4 of the 21st Community Learning Center Grant.

Fresh, Fruit & Vegetable awards have been made. Bayfield Elementary will receive \$8,900 for 2012-2013.

The Bayfield High School will receive \$45,000 for 2012-2013 from the Safe and Supportive Schools grant.

Grant awards for the "Pathways Program" Demonstration Grant for Indian Children have not been announced as of today, Tuesday, August 07, 2012.
