SUBJECT: June Board Report

Buildings and Grounds: The winter was hard on the buildings but helped the soccer field – it looks good. The plans were approved for the new bleachers by the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Sources this week. The elevators passed inspection with only a few minor repairs.

Transportation and Vehicles: The District's bus fleet has had a bad case of gremlins lately. Bus #2, Bus #3 and the mini bus had one or two trips to the shop with Bus #2 back up in Duluth. Bus #2 is a 2001 model, Bus #3 is 2007 and the mini bus is 2000. Water Week field trips went well with all the desired trips accommodated with no transportation issues.

Safety and Crisis Management: Fire drill planned for today with the Bayfield Fire Department on scene to evaluate. A tornado drill was performed with the Wisconsin Emergency Notification System in late April which went well. An evaluation/inspection of our playground equipment was performed with minor repairs - done at that time. More wood chips are needed at the playground for base padding. The District had a visit from Wisconsin Asthma Coalition and performed a school walk-through looking for asthma triggers and good indoor air quality. Planning and Projecting: The Island School evaluation/inspection; Remodel of high school office; bleacher removal; heater/ventilation controls upgrade for classrooms. All these projects will start when school gets out.
