Achievement

On March 1<sup>st</sup> Anne Sullivan attended the American Indian Student Achievement Network Conference.

On March 3<sup>rd</sup> four high school students attended a Future Quest field trip to the Bayfield County Courthouse and Jail with Mrs. Lewis-Hay and Mr. Lussenhop.

Also on March 3<sup>rd</sup> fifty-five high school and thirty-eight middle school band and choir students participated in the Large Group Contest at Northwestern High School. All groups earned a First Division Award.

On March 4<sup>th</sup> nineteen of Mr. Erickson's science students competed in the annual Toothpick Bridge Contest held @ UMD with two of the groups receiving 3<sup>rd</sup> place finishes.

Also on March 4<sup>th</sup> twenty-one high school students participated in the PLAN Test in the LRC. The PLAN test is a practice ACT test that helps the students prepare for that all important test.

On March 6<sup>th</sup> four middle school students participated in the regional National History Day event in Eagle River, WI with one student receiving an honorable mention and another student qualifying for the state event in Madison.

Also on March 6<sup>th</sup> four high school students participated in the Lakeland College Regional Science Fair in Sheboygan, WI. All four students won a variety of awards with one advancing to the Intel International Science & Engineering Fair in San Jose, CA in May.

During the week of March 8<sup>th</sup> thru 12<sup>th</sup> Mr. Erickson and 3 high school students attended the National American Indian Science Fair in Albuquerque, NM with one student winning the Traditional Award and finishing 1<sup>st</sup> in the Behavioral Science category and the other two students finishing 1<sup>st</sup> in the Team category.

On March 8<sup>th</sup> seven high school students completed the ASVAB Test in the LRC. ASVAB stands for Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery which is the most widely used multiple-aptitude test battery in the world. The ASVAB provides students with career information for various civilian and military occupations.

On March 9<sup>th</sup> eight high school students traveled to UW-Stout to compete in the regional Rube Goldberg Contest. The machine ran exceptionally well and the students finished in third place overall.

On March 10<sup>th</sup> Sally Kessler took fourteen students on an EIP field trip to Lake Superior College in Duluth, MN. EIP stands for Early Identification Program and they spend a lot of time exploring careers and visiting campuses.

Career exploration was also the topic for two visitors hosted by Mr. Doering in March.
