

Facility Update:

We broke all monthly records last January with 4151 visits, with over 1000 kids and over 1000 for our programs. February featured the start of swim lessons (both elementary and pre-school), Discover Scuba, and an afternoon Aqua Fit class (led by Missy Eid). We have a new partnership with the Red Cliff Early Childhood Center. They will be hosting Family Swim Days at the Rec Center on Saturdays through April.

Hunt Electric tested an LED light in our pool fixtures, found it needed to be modified, and is working to order the correct sized parts. The main axle for the intake air for the pool's ventilation system broke earlier this month. A new part (discontinued) has been found and ordered. Fortunately, the outgoing air blower is working well enough to maintain air flow and negative pressure in the pool deck area. Our hot water and hot tub heating systems were down for 24 hours when the pneumatic tubes that control the flow gates became blocked with moisture. We fixed the problem, but feel that we should move to switching these systems to electronic controls in the future. An ideal time to do this for the domestic hot water system would be when we replace the rusting tanks, planned for this spring.

Plans for Bayfield Winter Festival continue. We have a few new events, including Cosmic Disc Golf, a Bike on Water and Softball on Ice.
