## **Facility Update:**

Our summer programs are being advertised and we have a great lineup of things for kids to do, including Theater Camp, Thursday Fun Camp, Swim Lessons, WI Boater Safety, Martial Arts, Sailing (with North Coast Community Sailing), Soccer and free lunch. Dave Doering's tech ed class will be fixing up the skateboard area. The pool will open at noon weekdays after Bayfield School gets out.

All capital improvement projects are complete and settled for this fiscal year (ending June 30). The plan to pay for the repairs of the hot tub is as follows:

- \$19,630 out of this year's capital improvement funding
- \$18,860 out of next year's capital improvement funding (pay off loan)
- \$12,443 out of this year's RFR savings

Bayfield School students did some volunteer work at the Rec Center. Eva Pratt and 3 other high school students painted a beautiful mural on the walls around the new whirlpool, featuring an underwater scene. Many grade school teachers are scheduling end of the year swimming sessions for their classes. La Pointe school children are getting their swim instruction on Tuesday and Thursday mornings.
