

# Rec Center Report for April 2011

## **Facility Update:**

There is surprisingly strong interest in our new spring classes, and some have completely filled. Use is slowing from the winter peak, but we see new faces every week coming in for memberships. High school use has finished, but we are still hosting 1<sup>st</sup> grade swimming, the TAP program plus some specially arranged swims. Dave Doering and Steve Dunn were among the volunteers who helped install Skatelite (a highly durable, waterproof surface) on some of our skatepark ramps, which should last a very long time. Kids are out there every nice day, either skateboarding or shooting basketball.

The roof project is about halfway completed. Steve Dunn informed me that the roofers found rot in the north side gable end of the pool structure. This is no surprise, as we found and fixed rot in the south side gable end a year ago. Steve is supervising the project; please ask him for the latest update. The furnace installation project affected our building operations when, after the contractors drained and refilled the existing boilers as part of the installation, some of our heating pumps became airlocked. The pool did not receive heat and dropped to 79 degrees over the course of a week before we found the problem.
