SUBJECT: School Board Report

1. Attached are a number of legislation updates from WASB and School Administrator Alliance. The two more disturbing news items are the expansion of vouchers in the Green Bay School District and elimination of Wisnet Services in the State of Wisconsin.

2. On the good news side, attached is a letter from CESA 12 Director of Special Education stating the school district will receive \$13,308.46 as reimbursement for second half of 2010-2011 School Based Services.

3. The renewal for Workman's Compensation Insurance is in place for the July 1 anniversary date. The rate will be \$5.28 per \$100 and will have a flat dividend rate of 35 for employees in the 9101 category (custodians, kitchen, aids). The professional category is .55 per \$100.

4. Attached is a letter and renewal form from the National Association of Federally Impact Schools. The district has been a member of this organization and supported its efforts to lobby against cuts to Impact Aid. Any reduction of Impact Aid would have a negative effect on taxpayers in the Bayfield School District as the state allows districts to make up the difference on the local levy. It will be on the July agenda for action. The district has been a member since 2002.
