SUBJECT: August Board Report

Buildings and Grounds: Jamar has been here repairing 14 holes, rips in the rubber membrane roof on the main building and installing command control components on the old pneumatic room ventilators. The big push is on to finish everything in only 19 more days.

Transportation and Vehicles: I attended Nelson's Bus Service Training last week which composed of 4 days hands on training to diagnose and repair bus emergency systems, maintenance issues common to bus service, Braun handicap lifts and Allison Transmissions. Our Thomas flat nose bus #2 should be replaced next year as it is a 2001 and rusting out.

Safety and Crisis Management: The fire alarm system will be inspected and repaired this month along with fire extinguisher maintenance and recalibration. The high school office is getting remodeled to facilitate 2 more office's and phase 1 of making the entry more secure with another set of doors and window next year.

Planning and Projecting: I have enclosed the proposal from DSGW to do the assessment of the LaPointe school. The hall lights on the first floor will be replaced with LED bulbs. Currently the fixtures have 4 bulbs and will be retrofitted with 2 per fixture. Focus on Energy will pay us back \$150.00 from the incentive program. LED's are starting to come down in price so we will see more retrofit units soon.
