SUBJECT: March Board Report

Buildings and Grounds: Jamar Co. will start installing the boilers at the Recreation Center this week. The roof at the pool has been repaired due to the high winds last month. Almost three squares of shingles blew off. In the last five years, we have replaced \$26,000 work of shingles, tar paper, and flashing at the pool due to high wind tear off. The proposed metal roof at the pool will solve this and raise the value of this building. Every time shingles and tar paper are torn off in a storm, the underlayment is damaged leading to major roof problems in the future.

Transportation and Vehicles: All of the school vehicles have been re-registered with the state of municipal plates. Municipal plates are only \$5.00 a year compared to \$75.00 to \$110.00 for each vehicle. The pick-up truck received a new exhaust this month along with the mini bus. Bus #3 is in the process of having a camera system installed.

Safety and Crisis Management: The fire alarm system at the island school was inspected last week and a fire drill was performed - all worked fine. The District five alarm system received new batteries and a new control board that connects the Tech. Ed. building
