

Technology Coordinator Report September 8, 2010

1. The wireless bridge from Bayfield to LaPointe School had been reestablished. A tower was erected to clear the trees on the LaPointe side. The link has been up with no glitches since August 28th. We now have 36 Mbs of Bandwidth compared with the 1.5 we had with the T-1 circuit.
2. The District Tech plan has been approved by the DPI we are good for the next three years.
3. Installed 11 new Promethean Activboards to make a total of 22 in the District. We also had a trainer come in from First Tech in Minneapolis for three days to provide training on the boards.
