How much work should be posted? How much time is enough for students to be working?
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• As a general rule, the School District of Bayfield expectations for student time engaged in learning activities on a <i>Digital Learning Day</i> are:<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Grades 6-12: 2-3 hours○ Grades 3-5: 2 hours○ Grades K-2: 1 hour• More doesn't necessarily mean better. The focus needs to be on essential learning

targets/essential learning standards that students need to master to be successful. The goal is for students to make adequate progress where they are at in their learning.

Will attendance be taken each day?

- All teachers will enter attendance daily based on student engagement into Infinite Campus no later than 3:45pm.
