As you are all aware, Bayfield Schools will be closed indefinitely as the result of an order from Public Health. The district is monitoring the ever-changing situation with Coronavirus (COVID-19). We are committed to doing our part in preventing the spread of the virus and protecting the health and wellness of our students, families, and communities.

We understand the hardship that this situation puts on families in our district. During the closure, if there are items such as clothing, school materials, or other personal items you need, the District Office will be open from 7:45 - 3:45 pm., daily. Please call ahead if possible, to make arrangements.

Virtual learning options will begin on Wednesday, April 8, as a soft launch, and Monday, April 13, as the first day of learning with your child's teachers. Please review the question, answer form with this letter, and call the school if you have any questions or needs involving devices.

We will continue to offer breakfast and lunch to students during the closure.

We encourage you to follow CDC recommended guidelines of social distancing and hand washing. We will keep you informed of the latest updates as they occur.
