National School Lunch Program (NSLP) Equipment Assistance Grant

In December of 2018, I wrote a grant for the purchase of equipment through the NSLP Equipment Assistance Grant Program. I am pleased to announce that we received funding for \$25,809. This grant was for the purchase of a much needed six burner stove and a standing floor mixer.

Bayfield Recreation Center Boiler Update

The Bayfield Recreation Center came to us looking to replace a non-functioning Aerco boiler and a functioning Aerco boiler. I had Ben LaLone, from Johnson Controls, look at what was going on with the boilers and see if he could give us a quote on the replacements. The Bayfield Rec Center did provide us with a quote for \$62,940 from Blakeman Pluming & Heating (See Attached). Ben LaLone informed me that he did not feel the need to replace the 9-year-old functioning Aerco boiler since it was only at half of its life expectancy. He did agree we should remove the non-functioning boiler but felt with the other backup boilers, there was more than enough BTU's to provide the proper heating requirements for the building. At this point, he said he could give us a quote for a new system if we requested, but does not see a need for it.

Northern School District Trust Update (NSDT)

The switch from WPS to HealthPartners took place with relatively small complications. A couple of people did not get their health insurance cards so they had to be mailed out again. Other than that, everything thing is going very smoothly.

July 1 Estimate of General School Aids

The statutorily required July 1, 2019 estimate of general school aids for the 2019-20 school year are now available. The estimate is determined from the most accurate information available, using the \$4.74 billion appropriated for general school aids in the 2019-2021 state biennial budget that was submitted to the Governor last week. After subtracting the portion of our aid that funds the Milwaukee Schools Charter Program (\$2,320), our 2019-20 Equalization Aid estimate is \$141,831. That was only \$107 less than what was calculated on the initial budget.
