Athletic Report

1. Softball and baseball games are continuing to battle mother-nature. Games have been re-scheduled and looked at throughout the month of May, with not much help in re-scheduling.
2. Bayfield High School and Middle School athletics will be the first in the Indianhead Conference to have portable AED's for our coaches and athletes. We will be purchasing Phillips 6 AED's for next year. The AED's will be rotated between sport seasons. We feel this is an important part of giving our children, coaches, bus drivers and community members the quick response of the AED's at athletic events which do not have the ambulance or AED's available, especially for traveling, outdoor events, practice outside, etc. These are purchased through the WIAA and Allied 100 at a reduced cost.
*Note: We have received our AED's and they will ready to go in the fall.
3. Schedules for next year are being listed and prepared.
4. Bayfield School District is the Indianhead Conference host until July 1, 2018. We have revised the Conference Constitution.
5. On Wednesday, May 10, 2017 the Indianhead Conference Superintendents, Athletic Directors and Conference Commissioner have met at 6 pm at the Best Western/Chequamegon Hotel in Ashland. Discussions will be on the Commissioners role within the conference and evaluations. Discussion and explanation on the raised Conference Schools dues and any other business.
6. The revision of the Athletic Code handbook will be ready for June 1, 2017 and be effective starting July 1, 2017.
7. The Athletic Code reading will be held on Tuesday, July 10, 2017 at 6 pm in the Lunch Room/Commons Area. There are new additions to our policy book, such as, hazing policy and honesty clause.
8. Team pictures for baseball and softball were taken on Tuesday, May 02, 2017.
9. Weather has not been our friend this spring season.
10. Will still look into lights for the baseball/softball field. A quote has been received from MUSCO Company for lighting. Will look into.
11. Wrote a letter to the Bayfield Lions Club about the current concession stand on the field. Asking if the Lions would like to update and fix the concession stand, or should we get a group of people together and get materials and help to fix it for next spring season. We feel the concession stand is fixable, and some people have shown interest in helping fix it. The Lions do not meet until May 16, and hopefully we hear something after that date.
*Note: As of May 31, 2017, I have not heard anything from the Lions Club on the Concession Stand. With no response, the idea of volunteer and donations to help fix the concession stand will proceed.
12. Accept the letter of resignation from Cody Bailen for the High School Boys Soccer Assistant Coach. (see attached)
13. Post openings for the following positions: Assistant Boys Soccer Coach.
14. Ending of Softball and Baseball Seasons.
15. The new scoreboard has worked wonderfully this past spring season.

16. Ending of the Girls Soccer Season.
17. Reminding all Head and Assistant Coaches, the WIAA is requiring all coaches to be First Aid/AED/CPR certified to start coaching for the 2017-2018 school year. This has been a requested for the past two years to get this done, and if they are not Wisconsin Teaching Licensed, they will need to do a Coaching Fundamentals Class through the WIAA which can be done on-line. WIAA requirements and will be reinforced this spring and summer.
18. Excited about getting a school concession stand in the commons area by the gym. Construction will start this summer, and hopefully be ready for the fall.
19. Schedules for next year are getting in place and will be ready for July 1 for the printing of posters for fall.
20. Spring athletes will be recognized at the fall banquet. Graduating seniors will get their certificates and bars/balls before graduation.
21. Spring Coaching Evaluations are done and turned in.
