Needs: 1. We need to have a written agreement with Red Cliff Youth Center/Tribal and School District of Bayfield for the commitment for the Softball Field, Bathroom and Concession Stand facilities for the 2019 season.

### High School:

1. Received copies of Lease Agreements from the City of Bayfield
  - a. Need School District of Bayfield Superintendent signatures and returned to the City of Bayfield for files.
  - b. Terms: January 1, 2018 to January 1, 2024.
  - c. 3 Lease Agreements:
    - i. Soccer Field
    - ii. Baseball Field
    - iii. School Garden
2. Girls Softball finished their season on Wednesday, May 23, 2018.
  - a. Total girls started/tried out for the season: 15
  - b. Total girls finished the season: 14
  - c. 2 managers
  - d. Coaches: Caroline Twombly and Molly McCool
3. Baseball finished their season on Thursday, May 24, 2018.
  - a. Total boys started the season: 15
  - b. Total boys finished the season: 14
  - c. Coaches: Mark Defoe and Jeff Holvick
4. High School Track finished their season in May
  - a. Total participants: 1 boy – ran 1 mile and 2 mile
  - b. Coach: Dan Livingston
  - c. NOTE: Had interest from a few other students, grades/ineligible problems, and getting parents' permission/physicals, etc. were a hinderance.
5. Concession stand was available for the High School Baseball games put on by the Athletic Dept.

6. Concessions were available for Softball Regional at the Red Cliff Youth Center put on by the Athletic Dept.
  - a. Still working on concessions/bathroom facilities for the softball games for next year. Will be in contact with the Rec Center with a game schedule and work together for next year.
7. Coaching evaluations are finished for HS Softball, HS Baseball, Track and Middle School Coaches.
8. Athletic awards were distributed to the Seniors' before graduation, the other athletes' will receive their awards at the Fall Banquet.
  - a. Will look at a date for a Spring Athletic Banquet for next year.
9. Schedules for next fall and winter are finalized. Preparing to get officials for games.
10. Recommendation:
  - a. Dean Cook as the Middle School Activities Director for the 2018-2019 school year. Dean comes with a degree from UW-River Falls with Physical Education, Coaching and Special Education background.
11. Finalizing the end of the school year details, and getting next year program prepared. Fall and Winter sports are ready to go.
12. Waiting for coaches to turn in equipment and supplies lists for next year.

Middle School: Note: Since baseball, softball and track are new to the middle school this year, we look forward to better participation numbers next year.

1. Baseball: only 3 students showed up and tried twice for a number count.
2. Softball: Average 14-15 girls have showed up for practices
  - a. Coach Dean Cook is setting up a couple of games before the end of the school year so they have the opportunity to just play together.
  - b. Uniforms have been ordered through Heart Graphics.
  - c. Some equipment is supplied by the High School Softball program.
  - d. This program is headed in the right direction for our future feeder program.

3. Track – 1 student went out to learn about Track. He participated in a few meets and learned what track was about. He was very excited and is very interested in next year, he has been a great advocate in talking to his fellow classmates to join. Middle School Track is ran at the same nights as high school for all the schools in the Indianhead Conference.
