Currently we have 106 students within the special education department. There are 9 students with 504 plans. We have had seven (7) new referrals this year and we are working on three 3-year re-evaluations. During the month of September we reached a new high on the number of IEP meetings held in one months. The new high number is 39 meetings.

We have begun the first phase of our self-assessment. One day was set aside and Vicki Redenbaugh, Andrea DeBungie, Doug Jardine, Lori Heckman and I reviewed many IEP files. We will be continuing the process through the next month. Following that there are a number of further steps that will go into the summer months.

The Civil Rights Data Collection for the school year 2011-2012 has also been started. This is a process that is taking place with all of the school districts in the country.
