Currently we have 107 students with special needs. There 7 students with a 504 plan.

We have been meeting regularly with the Rtl committee and have a good start on getting that program going in the Bayfield School. We are working on planning the January 2, 2012 inservice. Doug and I recently attended a training on how the new SLD rules for eligibility will fit in with Rtl.

Linda Weber, Scott Stralka, and I attended a technical assistance program for implementing the Safe and Supportive School Grant and the AODA grant.

Bayfield recently completed a self assessment on transitions for students with special needs who are 16 years and older. We did very well and have no need for changes or corrections. Next year we will be required to complete an assessment for our special education programming. We are working on improvements now so that we will be able do well in this process.
