Troller After-school Program:

- Session# 3 average daily attendance has decreased from previous sessions to 65 students. Session #3 ends on March 15, 2012.
- Session #4 will begin on April 10 and end May 10, 2012.
- The TAP Homework Zone will continue to be offered to middle and high school students until the end of school year. The “in-between” session tutoring is provided through a partnership between TAP and the DPI Talent Search Grant.
- The Woodland Arts Club at the Red Cliff St. Francis Catholic School is growing in attendance as planned. The Club will offer two nights of art classes starting the week of March 5. TAP will continue to participate in this exciting new program by providing snacks and transportation home for students in Red Cliff.

Other Grants Update & Activities:

February 7 – Safe and Supportive Schools (S3) planning meeting.

February 14 – The Otto Bremer Grant Application for “**A Place-based Education Project to Address Obesity and Other Health Concerns and the Bayfield School Community Garden Expansion Project**” was mailed out today. The proposed project is a three-year program addressing our obesity problem through gardening and sustainability education and involves Red Cliff Mino Bimaadiziwin Garden and LaPointe Elementary and LaPointe Community Garden. Total program cost for three years is estimated at \$170,680. We will be notified by June 1, 2012.

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- The Department of Indian Education “**High School Pathways Transition Grant**” application was submitted on-line today through Grants.gov. The planning for this grant application was a collaborated effort between the ECC and the Bayfield School. The total program cost for four years was estimated at a little over \$1,000,000. We should hear from the DOE by mid-May, 2012.
- Submitted an Interim Report on the after-school program (21st CCLC) in PPICS, their on-line data collection tool.

February 29 – Completed mid-term evaluations on our two Farm-to-School members, Brittany Schmitt and Magdalen Dale. They have been doing an excellent job and both have decided to do another year with the Bayfield Schools!!
