

IT Systems Administrator Report October 24, 2012

1. State reporting is nearly done. Current reports include ISES Year End, ISES Third Friday Count, ISES Discipline, and ISES October 1 Child Count. This has been ongoing since the third Friday of September, and the deadline is October 28th.
2. The beginning of the school year is always a busy time. This year, standard equipment replacements included some staff laptops, replacements of the 2 mobile labs, and replacement of the workstations in the art room. Also, refurbished workstations were installed for the high school Alt Ed program.
3. The file server was replaced, and user data was migrated to the new server. There are still some shared files that need to be migrated. Other summer upgrades that were completed included upgrading the network security appliance, and upgrades to desktop software and network management software.
4. The district is beginning to use Google Docs for Education as part of our educational technology. The current trend in computing toward mobility and “cloud computing” makes this a good choice for users to have easy access to their data. As the staff becomes more familiar with these online tools, we hope to provide students access as well.

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
