Jeff Gordon and I conducted grade level meetings for 6-12. We reviewed the student hand book and our “Strive for Five” initiative. Elementary open house was a success. Many of our families took advantage of this wonderful opportunity to meet their child’s teacher.

Data:

Bayfield composite ACT scores from 2012-2013 was 21.2 with a five year trend average of 21.34. Bayfield is only .82 below the State’s average five year trend score. We also had a 10% increase in test participation for the 12/13 school year.

The Bayfield Elementary, Middle *and* High school were named a 2012-2013 “School of Merit” by Wisconsin PBIS (Positive Behavior Intervention Strategies) Network a state-wide education initiative.
