Board Report

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April 19, 2017

We completed the work on the Pupil Nondiscrimination report. It will be presented to the board at this month's meeting. A big thank you goes out to Nancy Larson and Barb Rebak for the work they did on this report.

I am currently working on the Civil Rights Data Collection report which is due on April 26th. This report is very lengthy and requires the input from a number of staff. The report has to be completed for each of our four (4) schools. This report is to be completed every other year. The information on this report is from the 2015-2016 school year.

We are completing the SOARing grant. This grant has been helpful in providing resources for the improvement of our reading program. We have funded the training for the Daily 5/CAFE framework, resources and equipment needed for that program, storytelling at the Winter Carnival, interventions for our resource library, conferences and training for our staff. We will be providing video, pictures and interviews to the state which will be included in their final evaluations.

Currently we have 99 students receiving special education services, three (3) students on a 504 plan and nine (9) with an at-risk plan. We have four (4) referrals that we are completing and the possibility of two (2) more Birth to 3 to come in.

I was approached by the RtI/PBIS Center about using the High School Success story for the WSBA journal. They have been requesting pictures and other pieces that might be included in the article. They were hoping to use a picture from Bayfield on their front cover. I am not aware of which month edition it will be published.

I have received correspondence from someone at DPI to discuss the sustainability of our Safe and Supportive School (S3) grant programming. I will keep you informed as that progresses.

We had our "Enroll and Explore" days for the 2017-2018 kindergarten. We had 28 students come. We are aware of a couple more students who would be age eligible for kindergarten, but they have not yet enrolled.

We continue to work on the summer school programming. The summer school information will be going out to students within the next two weeks.
