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K-5 Principal

Positive Behavioral Interventions & Supports (PBIS) -

In January 2018, at Bayfield Elementary School, there were 9 major referrals among 6 students.

These referrals were for:

- Physical Aggression (2)
- Defiance (2)
- Inappropriate Language (3)
- Harassment (1)
- Bullying (2)

Referrals by locations:

- Playground (3)
- Cafeteria (2)
- Classroom (2)
- Library (2)

January's data indicates:

- Wednesday's had the highest number of referrals with seven (7), followed by Thursdays and Fridays with one (1) each. Mondays and Tuesdays both had zero each (0).
- Referrals by grade: One (1) major referral in the kindergarten, two (2) in the 1st grade, one (1) in 4th grade, and five (5) referrals in the 5th grade.

Coaches Suggestions:

- The PBIS Coaches recommend that teachers continue to regularly discuss with students ways to deal with frustration rather than resorting to physical aggression.
- The PBIS Coaches recommend that teachers devise incentive programs to reward students from abstaining from physical aggressions.
- The PBIS Coaches recommend that teachers to continue to regularly discuss playground expectations and actively monitor students during recess.

Academics -

- Currently staff are reviewing mid-year math and reading data to determine what students need additional support and/or enrichment. New tier II intervention groups will be established and staff will begin small group interventions by the week of February 12th.
- Staff are currently working on vertically aligning and discussing their literacy practices by identifying elements of the Journeys Reading Program that they focus on, as well as the assessments they use. In addition, staff are identifying the amount of time spent on reading and writing during the day. We will continue to have conversations on our literacy practices, so we are all in agreement and aligned with best practices across all the K-5 classrooms.

School Climate -

- On January 12th all K-5 students participated in a K-5 Pow-Wow. Reggie Cadotte led the drumming and singing along with some HS boys from Wigwam Express.

- Lorie Erickson did a story and project using the story, *Mean Soup* at the Bayfield Family Forum Head Start on Jan 18th. The focus of the lesson was on managing emotions after a bad day.
- On January 26th paraprofessionals had a half day inservice. They had the opportunity to share what's working and what's not for them. In addition, Trent Hanson provided the paras with a PBIS training.
- In January we had six (6) initial IEP meetings, (15) annual and review IEP meetings, two (2) re-evaluation meetings, one (1) transition meeting, zero (0) 504 meetings and four (4) referrals.
