

NOTICE OF SCHOOL BOARD ELECTION

School District of Bayfield

April 2, 2024

Notice is hereby given to the qualified electors of the School District of Bayfield that a spring election for school board members will be held on the 2nd day of April 2024. Voting will be conducted at the regular polling places in each municipality from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. All polling places are accessible to elderly and disabled voters. Each qualified voter should vote in the municipality of which they are a resident. The following is a sample of the ballot, including the names of all candidates in the order in which they will appear on the official ballot. **Each elector may vote for one candidate for each school board seat. One candidate for each school board seat will be elected to a three-year term which will expire in April 2027.**

Official Ballot Nonpartisan Office April 2, 2024

Notice to Voters: If you are voting on Election Day, your ballot must be initialed by two election inspectors. If you are voting absentee, your ballot must be initialed by the municipal clerk or deputy clerk. Your ballot may not be counted without initials. (See end of ballot for initials).

If you make a mistake on your ballot or have a question, ask an election inspector for help. (Absentee voters: contact your municipal clerk).

To vote for a name on the ballot, fill in the oval next to the name like this:

To vote for a name that is not on the ballot, write the name on the line marked "write-in" and fill in the oval next to the name like this:
