2. Featured Communication

2.1 Effective Communication - School Climate (Giesregen & Swanson)

Melissa Giesregen, Elementary School Principal, reports that two playground assistants were hired, but they didn't have the proper training (PBIS). They modified schedule where one teacher from each grade are now going outside to assist the new playground supervisor. At the staff in-service held on January 2, 2020, a program was introduced for calming students. Every elementary classroom teacher created a box full of tools for students to self-regulate and calm down. A timer is in the box so students can see when a transition is coming. Weighted blankets are provided for early age classrooms and lap pads for grade three through five and were requested for a few high school classrooms. Also prepping students for testing and using the same format that was used last year - kindergarten & first grade students stay home while grades three through five take their exams. The testing dates this year are April 16 & 17.

Shellie Swanson, MS/HS Principal, wanted to recognize two staff members - Karen DePerry and Anne Sullivan, for receiving the Kohl's Teacher Fellowship Award this year. Congratulations to them. MS/HS also had several speakers recently - Jamie Nabozny, Star Nyara, and Bill Miller. Shellie is also working on the schedule for next year and working to be transparent in the process. To assist with this task, they met with staff and received good input. Lastly, the final class schedule is 90% done as of tonight and will hopefully be done by this Thursday.

2.2 Band Trip Update - Ron Borchers

They have already paid \$41,000 for the trip and have \$14,358 left in account with remaining payment about \$30k (\$15k short). Students have their own accounts for fundraising. Travel company gave two more weeks to make final payment. If the students do not go on trip we don't really know what refunds will be. Mr. Borchers thanked parents for speaking up about what we are facing. A school board member asked about those kids that can't afford to go and then heard that the chaperones go free. He is concerned students that can't pay can't go, but chaperones are paid for. Chaperones are working on trip. Students have had many opportunities to raise money and some students chose not to participate in the fundraising. He stated it is not fair students who don't help would get to go. The total cost of trip is just under \$70,000. Borchers will get email from tour company indicating a final date for refund so it can be disseminated to parents and school board. There are funds to pay for chaperones and the board wants to see that fund.

2.3 ETAL (Every Teacher a Leader) Attendance Report

A school board member asked about the high school attendance numbers and what is being done to improve. Mrs. Swanson and team are working close with families to identify reasons for absences. One response has been to modify student schedules. Also, students with chronic absenteeism are ones that have been absent from school for years. The middle school plan is working and 10-11 of those students are now in high school.

This conference used to be a common event in the state of Wisconsin. Many CESAs wanted to bring it back. Mr. Gordon asked that the board and other administration members let the board secretary know if you'd like to attend. Reservations are due by April 20.

Concerns about our attendance rate and if the governor will exempt those absences.
