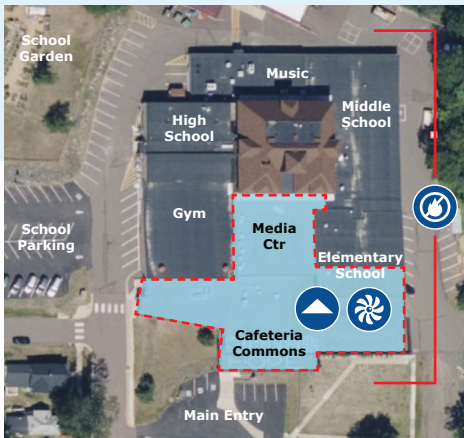
Facilities Improvement Vote | April 1, 2025

On Tuesday, April 1, 2025, the Bayfield School District will ask voters to approve a \$7.7 million facilities improvement referendum to address critical safety, accessibility, and infrastructure needs in our schools.

CURRENT FACILITIES CHALLENGES

Roof over the 2000 addition leaks into hallways and classrooms.



HVAC system is outdated and is the last of the five-year improvement plan.



There is not currently a fire sprinkler system in the school.



Roof replacement over the cafeteria, lobby, and classrooms completing a school-wide roofing update over the past seven years

Heating & ventilation system upgrade in the "2000 addition," replacing the original 25-year-old system and completing the school's five-year HVAC improvement plan

CURRENT FACILITIES CHALLENGES



Classrooms are outdated and in need of removal of hazardous materials and finishes.



HVAC system is intended for residential use and does not meet school needs.



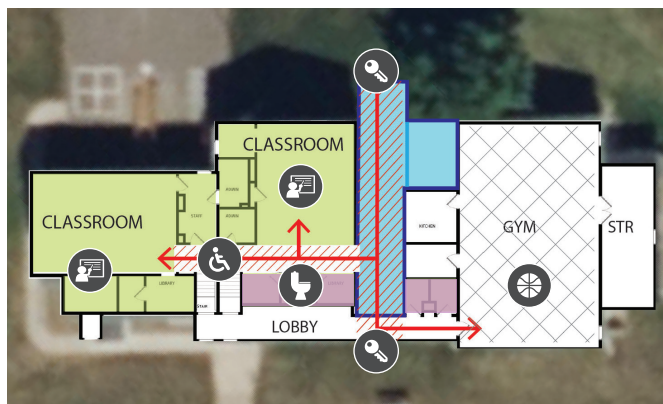
The school does not meet building codes for accessibility for primary rooms and entrances.



Bathrooms do not meet building codes for accessibility.



The gym has original finishes and needs to be replaced and re-freshed.

Safe and secure entrances with an ADA-accessible ramp to classrooms

Renovated hallway connecting classrooms to the accessible ramp and new entrances

Updated gym for improved functionality
