• As we prepare for the upcoming school year, I have been busy interviewing and hiring several new staff. We welcome two full-time and one half-time paraprofessionals, an internal teacher for the Kindergarten position, an internal candidate for the 1st grade position, a new third grade teacher, a K-8 counselor and a new 1-5 special education teacher. I'm excited to have these educators on our elementary team. They demonstrated a lot of knowledge, passion, experience and enthusiasm for educating and supporting our pupils.

• Every Tuesday Chris Plansky, Shellie and I have been meeting virtually with WISEdash Local to set up customizable data services that will help illuminate students need for being on target for graduation. WISEdash local is designed to integrate state and local data in a secure data warehouse and dashboard system for district staff to view. • On July 24th I attended a virtual meeting to learn about the new WISEdash 2.0 platform. This updated platform will be easier for teachers to utilize and it offers a more modern look at data. The menus, navigation and analysis capabilities will provide a cleaner user experience for teams/staff to analyze student data for the continual improvement process.
