Strategic Priority - Academic Achievement and Rigor

- On April 16-17 our K-2 students will stay home so our new K families can complete our kindergarten orientation paperwork and 3-5 students will complete the Forward Exams.
- We have been celebrating staff's efforts as 100% of staff have completed their lesson plans on time for the past three weeks. Four weeks ago 87% of the staff completed their plans. Overall, staff are working diligently to share their plans in the shared drive in a timely manner.
- On February 14th K-12 teachers completed the Response to Intervention Staff Perception Survey as well as the Math and Reading School-Wide Implementation Review. The RtI Coordinator (Janine Johanik), RtI Coach (Angela Botka), Missy Eid, Anne Sullivan and I met to review the results and began updating our action plan for the 20-21 school year.

Strategic Priority – Positive and Supportive School Climate

- Bill 527 was passed by Tony Evers on Monday, which changed the seclusion and restraint law requirements. At each of the building level staff meetings, I shared the changes to the law and updated our seclusion and restraint form. We also reviewed the process/protocol of making a response team call. Response teams are called when assistance is needed to protect the health and/or safety of an individual or group. The team will be called to assist a student to regain control of their body and emotions. All team members have training in verbal de-escalation and physical restraint.
- We will be sending a team to the Child and Adolescent Mental Health Conference in Duluth, MN on April 26-28. Conference attendees will be Missy Giesregen, Shellie Swanson, Patrick Kinney, Lorie Erickson and Karla Vinci.
