Academic Achievement:

March 13th and moving forward changed all previous planning related to standardized testing. Testing has been canceled at this point. Teachers have created online Google Classrooms to continue offering enrichments related to curriculum and priority standards. Grading has changed for third and fourth quarter to Pass/Fail. Third quarter was based on the seven weeks that school was held; some teachers offered a grace period for students to turn in work past the seven weeks.

Supportive Climate:

Weekly meetings are now being held with all MS staff and principal, as well as HS staff and principal, to share out and support one another. Teachers are super supportive of one another. All teachers now are considered "new teachers" as they learn and teach online. New "norms" are being developed for online learning, with possibility of looking into blended learning for the future.

Effective Communication:

A silver lining of the pandemic is the parent/staff communication has reached near 100%. Teachers, admin, and support staff worked diligently to make contact with each and every student and family. Devices were handed out. Google Classrooms, Google emails, and Google Hangouts are the primary sources of communication. A committee met to review recommendations for 20-21 MS Alt. Ed. program, four spots open and four candidates chosen.

Use of Data & Resources:

Book study related to trauma began. PBIS coaches meeting to review plan, making modifications where necessary, and planning how to move forward now that we are virtual learning. Classroom budgets were submitted, approved, and forwarded to financial office by April 15th deadline. Principals meeting virtually with Summative Teachers to finalize Educator Effectiveness (SLO/PPG) on the Frontline Platform; guidance was given from DPI on how to complete EE for 2019-2020 school year.

Attendance:

Teachers reporting 90% of students making connections weekly and engaged.
