#### Academic Achievement:

The required graduation requirement of passing the Civics Exam has been a high school focus over the last few months. ACP advisors have been reviewing material with sophomores and juniors to prepare them for the January 9th assessment. The exam is online and will have instant results for students.

#### Supportive Climate:

A holiday themed interactive appreciation week was held the week before winter break. Over sixty staff participated, with Camille Lemler being awarded the top prize basket filled with local business gift certificates.
