Positive and Supportive School Climate

The PBIS coaches have met and are planning on meeting with the elementary, middle, and high school staff to involve them in positive approaches to involve their students who have made learning a positive experience. It includes academic successes, online classroom performance, and other experiences the kids have accomplished. It will also consist of the PBIS rewards program similar to what's been done in the past. Prizes and other incentives the staff come up with will be included in the rewards program.

As we prepare for level two and for the students to come back to school, we are of the importance to make the transition for everyone safe and understanding to the children's needs; this includes academics, behavior, and the social, emotional awareness for everyone.

Academic Achievement and Rigor

The administration team is working together to reach out to families who could use additional support with their academics and attendance concerns. So far, as of November through December, the Principals and I have reached out to thirty-four different students and parents who may be experiencing truancy and other related issues regarding the current programming. We know that the correlation between low attendance impacts a student's academic performance. So, we offer any assistance available to help the families get through this period.

Home visits are happening too. Teachers, counselors, and administrators work together every week to assist families with home visits to help in various ways. We identify what the needs are to determine what staff members can help the families at home and bring whatever they need to help with their classes.

Effective Communication

We held a student-athlete, parent virtual meeting on Thursday, December 3rd. The turnout was good, with 12 students and six adults at the meeting. The coaches shared the monthly calendar's expectations and how the teams would participate with each other and on their own.

The meeting went well, with questions asked by everyone. More sessions to follow as we get closer to Level 2, in-person instruction.

Athletics Update

We are finalizing the sports schedules for the winter months and preparing our athletes for competition. The virtual practices are continuing with coaches and athletes doing the best they can to get physically and mentally ready. The season may be cut in half for games, we anticipate eleven out of a twenty-two game schedule. The Ski team has been practicing and training too. Hopefully, we can get more kids out to ski for the team. We will have more updates with sports as we move along after the holidays.
