Covid/Covid Response

Collaboration with Red Cliff Tribal Council, Red Cliff Community Health Center, Bayfield County Health continues.

- Nick Sawyer provides daily Covid positive numbers and data for staff in an email.
- Mitigation Committee has had some adjustments made, most notably the creation of the SUB mitigation committee that is a collaboration with several Red Cliff programs (Native Connections, TREE, Boys & Girls Club)
- Mitigation Committee (Dr Darling, Holly Weber, Nick Sawyer, Jackie Noha, Beth Paap meet weekly-Monday mornings @ 9:30)
- Covid positive numbers are on the decline in our district service area.
- Moving to level 2/hybrid instruction proposed to January 22 with a Level 2 start date of Monday, January 25th, the first day of the second semester.
- work on a protocol for daily staff health assessment via Frontline is underway.
- work on training and instructions for families to complete an online, via Infinite Campus, daily health survey will occur Jan. 18-22
- Communication with RCCHC and the Red Cliff Tribe to discuss collaboration on Covid testing at the mainland schools as needed.
- Beginning stages of realizing Covid testing on site.
 - collaboration with the Red Cliff Tribe
 - Chairman Richard Peterson and RCCHC Executive Director, Dianne Erickson assisting with this.

Effective Communication

- Clear communication with all staff and district partners continues through my efforts to reach out to people in order to chart a course that sees us have success during the pandemic.
 - weekly administrative team meetings
 - weekly all-staff Covid updates
 - weekly Covid specific mitigation committee meetings
 - newly formed sub-committee to address mental health support for staff and students
 - meeting with all newly hired employees to hear how things are going, answer questions, get feedback from them on the district hiring process, etc. As of 12.18.20 I have met with 7 of the 8 newly hired staff. Once the latest approved hires are on board, I will set up meetings with them.
 - meeting with staff, I will continue to set up 30 minute "check-ins" with the staff I supervise and then move toward meeting with all staff as my time allows. Realistically aiming for 2 check-ins a week.
