- IEP meetings come prepared review past testing (3-year evaluation, state, district, etc.), talk to all teachers BEFORE the meeting (not all teachers attend the meeting, but we need their input), be sure to include measurable behavior data and ACP/transition information. All of this information can be put on the PLOP prior to the meeting.

 - o DLM is the only state testing approved to take place off site. May want to start thinking about how our virtual students will be taking the Forward and ACT in the building.
