### *Attendance, Truancy, and Family Connections Collaboration Team*

The committee has had multiple meetings to coordinate services to find solutions to help with truancy-related issues. Individuals from the Bayfield School, the Red Cliff family Services programs, Red Cliff Planning Department, and the Red Cliff Community Health Center are participants on the committee. The topics have been Tribal Court truancy updates, the vacancy for next year with the Home School Coordinator position, the Red Cliffs Clinics involvement with families, and how to best engage them with the school and clinic. We will continue to review pre-covid data and current data to improve the school district's attendance concerns regarding truancy and chronic absenteeism.

### *Athletics Update*

The student-athletes completed a successful Covid related season. The teams competed with our conference schools taking on the necessary mitigation daily and game day requirements for competition. The coaches worked hard to get the players and teams ready to go for their shortened seasons.
