### Athletics Update

- First/Aid CPR Training for all coaches for the upcoming year. The Bayfield Recreation and Fitness Resources Center will be providing the training in July or early August. It will be for the full two-year certification with a refresher next summer to follow.
- The Athletic Code Reading for student-athletes and parents/guardians will be held in the cafeteria this month on Wednesday, July 28, at 6:00 pm. The WIAA requires each school to provide the code reading one time per year. There will also be paperwork forms for the families to complete before the sports season starting; Physical cards, medical documents, concussion protocols, etc.
- Fall team schedules for volleyball, boys' soccer, middle school, high school boys and girl's cross country, and middle school basketball are close to completion. The plan is to have them ready for upcoming athletic code reading for the coaches and student-athletes.
- Coaching vacancies will be posted for the girl's 8th-grade basketball team and the boy's high school basketball team. They will be complete by the next school board meeting on Monday, August 16.

### PBIS (Positive, Behavior, Intervention, & Supports)

- We are planning for the first week and early months for the start of the school year. Working on a ninety-day calendar will include the weekly strive for five topics, the early PBIS all-school "Kick-Off," and the fall staff and parent surveys.
- Reviewing the prior year's awards program and weekly resources offered for the school-wide staff. Once the school year starts, we can begin organizing and creating the weekly routines for each school building, such as the daily "high five" and attendance awards.

### Academic and Attendance Supports

- Working with the Principals to identify students who will need additional academic and attendance supports for all grade levels K-12. The district's Infinite Campus program, WISEdash Local information system, and teacher feedback are used to identify the areas of need for our students.
- The goals are to support our teachers and families with school resources that will positively impact student learning.
