Health & Wellness Committee

The Health & Wellness Committee will address the Wellness Policy in order to make a recommendation to the Policy Committee for Board approval and then will complete the triannual assessment. Meeting is scheduled for September 22, 2021.

Pupil Services

School Counselors, Dan Livingston and Karla Vinci, have completed beginning of the year scheduling changes for students and are moving forward with in-class support of the use of the Xello program (a software supporting students in becoming future-ready) in middle and high school ACP classes as well as direct school counselor instruction K-5. K-5 Xello instruction will also be used.

Work will continue to enhance our eMTSS (Equitable Multi-Tiered System of Support).

- The M-Team met 9-9-21 to establish purpose and norms. This group will be reviewing baseline student data in order to better and more efficiently pair student needs with appropriate interventions. This group will meet again 9-16-21.
- Karla Vinci and Tracey Henegar from the Bayfield County-UW-Madison Extension, trained middle and high school teachers in Youth Mental Health First Aid during in-service. An additional training session will be held for paraprofessionals and additional staff on October 11.
- Set up of the b.e.s.t. (Behavior Emotional Social Traits) universal screener will be taking place for the screener to be completed in October. This behavior screener is designed to help educators identify students who may benefit from additional positive behavior supports.
- The creator of the P.A.T.H (Purpose-Attitude-Team-Hope) curriculum, Tasha Schuh, spoke to the middle and high school staff regarding her curriculum that will be implemented in the health and school connect classes. Tasha will be coming to Bayfield to speak to the middle and high school students on October 7, 2021.

Special Education

Eight IEP/parent meetings have been held. Scheduling constraints have made department meetings difficult to schedule so case managers are holding individual meetings with the director in order to review changes in evaluation forms, review IEP/evaluation procedures, identify and address individual student needs and interventions, and lesson plans.
