# **Covid/Covid Response**

- Continued consultation and collaboration with Red Cliff Community Health Clinic, and county health departments
  - decision of district to utilize Covid Clinic Inc. to manage in house testing to include Test to Stay
    - assurance that testing supplies will be consistent and available
  - Discussion with RCCHC's Covid team on district aligning with CDC's recommended 5 day quarantine—presently at 10 days of quarantine.
  - · CAT response time responsibilities will lessen with Covid Clinic taking over testing
    - CAT and health office will continue to assist with contact tracing as needed
