Supportive Climate:

High school forum met with Washburn HS. The discussion at the table was very positive and our students look forward to re-meeting with the neighboring students to continue the relationship building process.

A team has been organized to attend the Wisconsin Indian Education Association conference. It will be held in May at the Indian Community School in Franklin, Wisconsin.

Effective Communication:

Book study is continuing. The book *Rethinking Sexism, Gender, and Sexuality* is the chosen title. This group has met and will continue meeting on Tuesdays after school to explore topics.
