Update on Impact Aid

We have received notice that the Impact Aid Program Office is ready to distribute FY22 funds as soon as they hit the Impact Aid Grant System. We were notified our payment would be \$1,053,286.00. That will make the total for funding this year \$2,356,246.00, which is \$787,540.00 less than what was budgeted.

Coronavirus Relief Funding/ESSER (Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief)

We are currently using these funds to pay for additional staff and supplies dealing with coronavirus. We have at this time spent 62% of \$2,280,903 in ESSER funding we were given for use through 2024. We will spend approximately \$285,219 for the remainder of the year. We will have approximately \$1,136,780 for the next school year.
