Supportive Climate:

Partnership with Northland College to be site for student teacher in our high school Science department beginning mid-April.

Queer Prom was held locally with support from local agencies and involving students from three school districts. Cathy Smith was our district's main contact person, along with student leader Allison Rogers. There has been a lot of great followup comments from students, staff, and community members.

I've completed Title IX Coordinator and Investigator training through NEOLA's partner company Institutional Compliance Solutions (ICS).

Effective Communication:

Met with BEA teacher reps. I will be developing a flow chart for Calendar Committee procedures and approval. A compilation of Google Calendars that are in use throughout the district is also being drafted.

Use of Data & Resources:

Behavior referrals have been on the rise. Currently have 292 referrals this year. A major rise compared to last year, but last year was mostly virtual and then a hybrid model for second part of the year. The biggest offense has been for skipping classes. An alarming rise for referrals has been for suspicion of drug use, including nicotine vaping and marijuana. Behavior data attached below for YTD and past year comparison. While technology violations/phone use has gone up, since adding the video recording consequence in the student handbook those offenses have dropped.

Attendance:

Attendance trends have taken a dip, with the average for grades 6-12 at 86.63%YTD.

Unexcused attendance attached below. Two high days were the Friday before our spring break and the Monday after the Easter weekend. One is district and the other is grades 6-12.
