Revenue from Fund Balance

Because we will not receive any revenue until early February, I have had to take money out of our investments where we keep our fund balance. I have moved \$502,000 from CD's we have with RBC Investments. The next big amount of money we will be receiving will be from our tax levy. This is the first time ever I have had to transfer money out of fund balance. In addition, because the federal government is running on a stopgap-funding bill, we have not been receiving any Impact Aid revenue.

Coronavirus Relief Funding/ESSER (Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief)

We are currently using this these funds to pay for additional staff and supplies dealing with coronavirus.

ESSER II Funding \$671,580.00 - \$319,741.72 = \$351,838.28 ESSER III Funding \$1,509,323.00 - \$52,020.27 = \$1,457,302.73 Balance of funding = \$1,809,141.01
