Academic Achievement:

The elementary teachers have been utilizing the morning collaboration time to focus on supporting all students in ELA and math. Grade level teams have been scheduled to meet to discuss ELA interventions and instruction with Janine Johanik (Dean of Curriculum) and Angela Botka (reading interventionist). Teams have also been scheduled to meet to discuss math interventions and instruction with Tammy Weber (math interventionist) and me. During these weekly meetings we use our data to drive discussions about which students are in need of interventions, what interventions will be used, how the interventions are going, and how the universal instruction is or isn't meeting the needs of our students. Grade level teams are using these meetings/discussions to assist in their planning.

Supportive Climate:

With the number of staff illnesses and quarantines on the rise, I have witnessed our entire staff rise to such a high level to support one another and the students of Bayfield. Staff have been willing to fill in and replace colleagues on short notice. Many have gone without their own prep times due to coverage needs or other staff being out. I am often amazed that we are even able to keep our doors open some days, much less our students engaged in their learning. It could not be accomplished without our entire staff supporting each other through these difficult times.

We are in the middle of conducting our fall conferences with students and families. This is a great opportunity for our teaching staff to communicate with families about student strengths and areas that may need growth such as academics, social awareness, and emotional health.
