Pupil Services School Counselors

- Karla has been finalizing schedules and will be meeting with seniors to review their schedules, final year plans, and post-secondary steps.

- Karla, Stephanie Lewis, and Shellie Swanson completed a summer long virtual Education and Training Pathway Development series through CESA 12 to gain insights to pathways that promote vocational training in the areas of early childhood and education in general.

- Letters for Jump Start have gone out and the freshman students will be attending August 22.

Other

- A number of staff members attended the annual b.e.s.t. Universal Behavior Screener (virtual) on July 27. Eric Hartwig, the creator of the screener, will provide a brief overview and demonstration for the district staff in October during in-service, prior to the first screening window.

Human Resources

- Interviews for the final paraprofessional positions were held August 3, with six outstanding candidates.

- Interviews for the vacated special education teacher/case manager position are being held Monday, August 15.

Special Education

- Indicator 11-Initial Evaluations is being submitted (due September 30.) Sixteen students were evaluated and fourteen qualified for services in the 2021-2022 school year.

- Two special education case managers attended the PLC Conference in Minneapolis, MN, August 9-11. Ten total staff members attended.

- All Bayfield staff are being given the opportunity to obtain an Autism Spectrum Certificate through Nicolet College -
