## **Dean of Curriculum and Instruction Monthly Report**

Date: September 15, 2022

Below is a list of items I have been working on or completed since my last report.

- Staff has been reaching out to me with curriculum questions, and I am supporting them the best I can.
- The following curriculum was submitted for purchase
  - Additional Envision Math workbooks
  - Reboot for four teachers
  - FastBridge for Special Ed
  - Digital materials for ELA are in the process of being reviewed. I am waiting for confirmation from teachers who will be using it.
  - Sources of Strength SEL curriculum for Dan Livingston
- · Mystery Science kits have not yet arrived, they are on back order. The expected arrival is mid-October
- The Cable Natural History Museum will be at Bayfield Elementary from October 18-19. Teachers are signing up now.
- The following teachers and I have met to discuss curriculum and instruction. I plan to create a schedule for October and November to meet with all teachers.

- Cathy Smith and I hope to attend a PD on Financial Literacy in October. It is required for graduation and the conference will provide us with curriculum and instruction support.
- I am organizing a group to participate in the career readiness community of practice conference through the DPI. The conference is free and there is a limited amount of \$1000 stipends available for teachers, to be used for time meeting monthly to develop action plans. There are a total of 6 meetings throughout the school year. The conference fits in well with our strategic plan.
- The district assessment dates have been set for the 2022-2023 school year.
- MAP testing for the Fall will be September 19<sup>th</sup> -October 7<sup>th</sup>. The test will be given to all student's grades K-12 in ELA and Math. A quick guide has been created to help support teachers with test administration and I will be available to support them for the 3 weeks.
- The New Teacher Mentoring program is up and running. The teachers were provided information to register for CESA sponsored training. Our first-year teachers attended. I will start to follow up on progress in the coming weeks.

- I trained two SPED teachers on using Newsela with their students.
- I still need to find a High School PBIS Coach. I have sent out a couple of emails, but received no responses from teachers. I will keep trying to find someone.
- Interviews were conducted on Thursday, September 15, 2022, for the positions listed below. We had 1 applicant for each of the positions.

  - Middle School PBIS Coach
