Student Success:

Jump Start was held August 22nd. Counselor Vinci, class advisors Suelflow and Bodin, resource teacher B. Boyd, and principal Swanson all attended a full day event with students. Day included orientation at school with schedules handed out, followed by an afternoon at the trampoline park in Duluth. Team building seemed to be successful. Letters went out inviting students and parents, with a follow-up phone call from Principal Swanson.

High school class meetings have been scheduled and schedule shared with staff and class advisors for the 22-23 school year.

Student & Staff Health and Wellbeing:

Welcome back assemblies were held the first two Fridays for all 6-12 staff and students. First assembly included State Superintendent Dr. Jill Underly and WNBA player Megan Gustafson. Every Teacher a Leader (ETaL) met August 16th to set goals and objectives for the school year. Teams focus is attendance. Will begin meeting bi-weekly to look at data. Team will do share outs with staff for at-risk students. Will work to make connections and offer support at all levels; ES, MS, and HS. Team will review list of excused/exempt codes.
