### Student Success:

All high school students will be taking the required Civics Exam on October 25th. Several staff worked collaboratively to prepare assessment, update questions, and share out practice questions with teaching staff.

### Student & Staff Health and Wellbeing:

The no device policy is going well. Only a few hiccups, but overall the socialization and face-to-face interactions have improved.

### Community Collaborations and Partnerships:

Brighter Future Initiative (BFI) has been working in the district with middle school students twice a week.

The Boys & Girls Club will be partnering with our district to bring in a guest speaker on November 10th (Bronson Koenig) and a three session/two day basketball camp for grades 2-12 on November 11th and 12th.

Working closely, weekly, with law enforcement to help with prevention and follow-up in regards to physical altercation and non-physical conflicts.

Law enforcement and EMTs have been invited to participate during our violent intruder hands-on training. Staff will be given an opportunity to ask questions about response situations and roles.

DPI Gear Up consultant and UW Stout representatives have spent time with high school students providing secondary education opportunities. An overnight field trip is planned for October 25 - 26 is currently planned.

A Sportsmanship Summit is planned for November for our students and others in our athletic conference at CESA 12.

### Excellence:

All licensed staff have begun the Effectiveness Project (EP), evaluation system, and almost all have completed the Student Learning Objective (SLO) and Professional Practice Goal (PPG) that were due October 15th. A session was held after school for new teachers to get assistance and an overview of the program. Mentors also support new staff on completion.
