We are still working on getting an estimate for adding playground cameras. We have ruled out one possible existing power source in that area, and we are looking at other options. At this time, we are waiting on a response from the vendor for other options.

The new equipment that was backordered from last summer and fall has finally arrived. We are ready to install the new interactive whiteboards in the third grade classrooms, and to proceed with providing wireless service for the outdoor classroom. At this point, we will probably push those projects to summer.

We are planning to use our student information system, Infinite Campus, for recording attendance and participation in our summer school program. This will take significant effort to set up, so we are beginning the process now. When complete, it should make the state reporting process for summer school easier.

Planning is underway for summer projects. Along with normal scheduled equipment replacements and maintenance, we hope to improve the security, monitoring, and documentation of our network. We are also working with Joel Shilman to switch the power systems for our network, telephone system, and security system to our backup generator. Currently, we have anywhere from 30-60 minutes of backup battery power in the case of power failure.

As always, our assessments of equipment scheduled for replacement continue. We will be continuing this throughout the year, and we will schedule replacements and upgrades as needed.
