Student Success:

MAP snapshot is included for comparison of Fall 2022 and Winter 2023 assessments. Six different snapshots include three for middle school and three for high school. Those snapshots are broken down into three more subgroups, including math, reading, and language usage.

Attendance updates for middle school and high school has reports attached. Middle school has an enrollment of ninety-four students. The year to date (YTD) attendance averages 88.48% attending. Middle school has 46.4% of our students considered chronically absent. High school has an enrollment of one hundred eight students. The YTD attendance averages for high school is 85.33%. High school also has a high average chronic absenteeism at 50.4% of our students considered chronic.

Four candidates for our middle school Alt. Ed. program have been chosen by our educator team. Letters of invite are scheduled to go out this week. Candidates will be allowed to shadow other students in the program on March 30th.

Community Collaborations and Partnerships:

I attended the CESA 12 CTE work day with a team of CTE teachers. CTE (Career & Technical Education) staff who also attended were Dave Doering, Mark O'Neill, and Melinda Suelflow. Dean of Curriculum & Instruction was also in attendance. Pathways are continuously looked at to meet current student need. Carl Perkins budget requests for 23-24 were drafted. A copy of Bayfield Carl Perkins budget request is attached.

Sugar Bush trips are planned for the next three weeks for middle school students, as well as a few high school groups.

Excellence:

Two high school students participated at the State Ski meet in LaCrosse on the weekend of February 18-19. Congratulations to Elvira B. and Neenah M.

Four high school students participated at the sub-Districts for Forensics (4N6); all four qualified for Districts; two will be attending with Coach Woodworth.

Efficient Use of Resources:

Middle school had two more Ski Days at Mt. Ashwabay. One day was incorporated into the Phy. Ed. curriculum with expectation of some sort of physical activity being a major part of day; activities other than down hill ski offered were snowboarding, snowshoeing, cross-country ski, and snow fort building.
