Student Success:

GEAR UP program took five students on an overnight college visit to UW Stevens Point, UW Madison, and Northcentral Technical College. The GEAR UP program is also part of the UW Green Bay "Rising Phoenix" program. We have three sophomores accepted into the Rising Phoenix program and will be meeting with their instructional coach in the coming weeks. GEAR UP is part of the Wisconsin Educational Opportunity Programs (WEOP). WEOP also has offered and is hosting an online miniseries called Paying for College. WEOP students and families were invited to sign up for the five week series.

Student & Staff Health and Wellbeing:

Kudos to our middle school advisors, Eric Iversen and Molly Wirsing, for bringing back the Friday Night dances for our students. Emails and messages from a variety of community members have been received thanking our middle school staff for hosting this much needed social event for our students.

Mindful Leaders Empowerment Group (MLEG) also met this last month. I attended this session on the morning of April 11th.
