For the past month, I offer the following summary;

- on 4/25 attended a City of Bayfield meeting on parking
 - discussion of parking project
 - Parking Management Plan (PMP)

 - we have an App but it is not used, why?
 - What do we need from a website?
 - How would our constituents use an App?
 - Reason: to look at tools to effectively communicate with students and families. To promote all the positive things our district is doing that support the education of our students.
- Exploring Yondr (<https://www.veryondr.com/>)
 - a locking phone pouch system for cell phones
 - \$25-\$30 per pouch, includes locking stations, training of staff, and tech support.
 - discussion with Shellie about piloting this with the Middle School next year.
 - This tool would support our NO cell phone use policy
 - we still struggle with student cell phone use in school
