- on 5/18 met with Jacob Kaiser of the RFR/Rec Center
 - Rec Center moving to 24 hour access to the workout rooms
 - RFR board is in the beginning stages of a strategic plan

 - Students from all grade levels were celebrated for their high academic achievement, their intellectual curiosity and their commitment to scholarly excellence and community engagement.
